Opportunity Scholarship

- Complete 1 advanced class (CE/AP) in the following areas:
 - Science
 - Math
 - Language arts
- Must complete FAFSA
- More details on applying to come!
- Replaced Regents
 - You can use Regents requirements for this year only

EDGE Scholarship

- \$2,000 tuition waiver per year for four years (\$1000 per semester)
- Complete a total of 12 credit hours (or more) of any combination of concurrent enrollment courses
- Earn a minimum 3.0 (B) cumulative grade point average on all concurrent enrollment course work
- Must fill out Weber Specialized Scholarship Application by December 1st

- Friday, November 19, 2021 Sterling Scholar selections will be announced.
- Monday, November 22, 2021-Mandatory meeting for all Sterling Scholar nominees at 2:30 in the library.

- WXHS Test Dates:
 - Oct 23

Note: You can take the ACT at any ACT location, not just WXHS

Most colleges are not requiring ACT scores, but some do for scholarships.

- Many Utah colleges are requiring vaccines to attend.

 - Medical exemptions available but difficult to get


Got Transcripts?

 To have official transcripts sent to prospective colleges/universities, you need to fill out a Transcript Request Form available online or in the counseling center.

Most colleges use electronic versions

- If you're applying out of state university, you will need to provide the address and contact to Mrs. Hewitson
- Taking CE? You must send your college transcript as well as your WXHS!!!
- After you graduate, you will use Parchment to request transcripts.



Letters of Recommendations

- Carefully consider who you would like to write the letter and give them plenty of time, at least 2 weeks' notice!
- Fill out a letter of recommendation form to help your recommender write an effective letter (on website)
- If possible, save a copy of the letter to use in the future
 - Some recommenders do not share their letters
- NOTE: No letter of recommendation is required or considered for regular admission application to the University of Utah

Academic Letter

The Academic Letter is the highest academic achievement awarded by Woods Cross High School.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- At least a 3.75 GPA over 6 terms (10th 12th grade)
- Take at least 2 qualifying honors, AP, and/or CE classes (see application for list)
- At least 7 of the 8 classes taken during qualifying terms must be classes which affect the term's GPA (not pass/fail classes). Classes such as Released Time are NOT counted towards the seven. Students who take released time AND are office/teacher aides or take directed research do NOT meet the requirements.

APPLICATIONS DUE APRIL 15th, 2022

NOTE: Senior fourth term grades do not count towards Academic Letter. All requirements must be met by the end of third term senior year.

Academic Honor Cords:

- Woods Cross High School awards academic honor cords based on the following criteria:
 - GOLD: 3.75 GPA or higher
 - **SILVER**: 3.5 3.749 GPA
- Academic honor cord eligibility is determined using the cumulative GPA from 9th grade through the 3rd term of a student's 12th grade year.
- Students who qualify for honor cords will receive a notification shortly after the end of third term of their senior year.
- The fee for academic honor cords is \$6 payable on MyDSD under Payments > Optional Fees> Grade 12 Honor Cord. The deadline for payment is Friday April 15, 2021.
