COVID Statement

On March 16, 2020, ISK closed its campus and classes continued synchronously online through virtual learning for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. During this time, our grading policy was modified, not allowing students to receive a lower grade than Semester I, in order to accommodate the social and emotional wellbeing of our students. The 2021-2022 school year started with on campus instruction, however, ISK continues to be restricted by the local government and is not allowed to provide after school activity opportunities for students. During COVID, Extra-Curricular Activities and Service Learning have been halted.

School Calendar: The school year includes 180 days and is divided into two semesters. The typical course load is 8 courses each semester. The school day is comprised of four 80 minute classes that meet on an alternating day schedule.
