Canteen Service	Students can choose to access the food services provided by the canteen operator with payment being made directly to the canteen service provider.
Books and other school resources	Textbooks based on curriculum requirements, as sold by the school's authorised vendor and payment is made directly to the vendor. The replacement of lost or damaged textbooks, exercise books, library books and other school resources are to be funded by the student/family.
School Uniforms	Uniforms are sold by the uniform provider and payment is made directly to the uniform provider.
