The tasks of the BHV Lead/Head in-house Emergency Response Officer at each school are:

	<ul> <li>planning of meetings to agree division of tasks of in-house emergency response officers</li> <li>formulating/adjusting the evacuation plan and the shelter plan</li> <li>communicating the evacuation plan to relevant parties</li> <li>planning, managing and evaluating the performance of the evacuation plan twice a year</li> <li>(organising the) provision of the necessary instructions in the school building with a view to</li> <li>evacuation</li> <li>checking and, if necessary, supplementing the contents of the first aid box</li> <li>arranging for a list in the school with up-to-date names and telephone numbers of</li> <li>emergency services, such as doctors, ambulance, fire brigade and police</li> <li>maintaining the accident register, reporting to the director</li> </ul>
Miscellaneous	
	<ul> <li>where necessary, maintaining contact with external organisations such as the fire brigade or</li> <li>the safety, health and welfare service</li> </ul>
