### Welcome & Approval of Minutes

### Community Council Responsibilities:

Schools participating in the School LAND Trust program are required by Utah Code and Utah State Board of Education (USBE) Rule to have **certain items on their individual school website**, and to provide notice of meetings on the school website one week before the council meeting is held. The School Children’s Trust section of the USBE has been tasked with reviewing a portion of school websites annually to determine compliance.

- The Community Council is required to help with the school safety plan and the school improvement plan.

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## Halloween Traditions at Parkside

- The parade is a strong tradition and the council feels that the parade is still an appropriate and the council voted in favor for the Halloween activities including a parade.
- The Halloween parade will be Oct 28<sup>th</sup> and the classroom teachers will determine when to have their own classroom parties.

## Report Card
