# Working with PowerSchool Mobile App

# **Connecting PowerSchool Mobile App to PowerSchool**

After a user downloads the mobile app to their device, the app will need to point to the correct PowerSchool server to authenticate. The PowerSchool Mobile and PowerTeacher Mobile apps walks the user through an on-boarding process. Most users will enter a four-character code that is used to locate the PowerSchool server. If a user does not know their District Code, they can search for their district by district name or school name. They can also manually enter the PowerSchool server URL. In either case, the mobile apps will search for the district code via PowerSource and/or connect via the server if the mobile services are accessible.

## Region 14 District Code HMRK

The district code is a four-character code that can be entered on the sign in screen to point the mobile apps to the PowerSchool mobile services. This code is auto generated when the PowerSchool server is registered with PowerSource. The district code should never change for your district. If PowerSchool registers with a new domain name, the district code will update to the new domain name.

Anytime the district code is updated, it will be validated with PowerSource.

At this point, the user enters their username and password to authenticate with PowerSchool.

#### How to Locate the District Code


The district code automatically appears on the lower left portion of the navigation menu of the

PowerSchool Student and Parent portal and the PowerTeacher portal.

- 1. Sign in to PowerSchool Student or Parent portal.
- 2. On the left navigation menu, locate the District Code located at the bottom of the



3. menu. If no code appears, the server is not registered with PowerSource.



# How to Locate the District Code on the Administration Portion of PowerSchool

- 1. On the start page, choose **District** under Setup in the main menu. The District Setup page appears.
- 2. Under Plugins, click **Mobile Registration**. The Mobile Registration page appears.
- 3. If the PowerSchool server is registered with the PowerSource mobile registration server, the Mobile District Code appears. If the PowerSchool server is not registered, dashes appear.

# Searching by District Name and/or School Name in the Android App

Users can search for the PowerSchool server by district name or school name.

- 1. Open the PowerSchool Mobile app.
- 2. On the Sign In screen tap **Help** or the question mark in the upper right corner.
- 3. On the District Code Help screen, tap **Search for Your District**.
- 4. Enter the full district name or school name in the field(s) provided, and then tap **Search**.
- 5. On the Search Results screen, tap the correct district name.
- 6. On the District Details screen, tap **Connect to this PowerSchool**.

7. On the Sign In screen, enter your username and password, and then tap **Sign In**.

# Manually Entering the PowerSchool Server Address in the Android App

If you share the PowerSchool server address with the parents and students, they can enter it in the mobile app manually.

- 1. Open the PowerSchool Mobile app.
- 2. On the Sign In screen tap **Help** or the question mark in the upper right corner.
- 3. On the District Code Help screen, tap **Search for Your District**.
- 4. Enter the PowerSchool server address in the field provided, and then tap **Submit**.
- 5. On the Sign In screen, enter your username and password, and then tap **Sign In**.

### Searching by District Name and/or School Name in the iOS App

Users can search for the PowerSchool server by district name or school name.

- 1. Open the PowerSchool Mobile app.
- 2. On the Sign In screen tap **Where's My District Code**.
- 3. Select **Search by School or District**, then enteryour school or district name in the search field. Select the district when it appears on the screen.

# Manually Entering the PowerSchool Server Address in the iOS App

If you share the PowerSchool server address with the parents and students, they can enter it in the mobile app manually.

- 1. Open the PowerSchool Mobile app.
- 2. On the Sign In screen tap **Where's My District Code**.
- 3. Select Enter Server Address.
- 4. Enter the PowerSchool server address in the field provided, and then tap **Submit**.
- 5. On the Sign In screen, enter your username and password, and then tap **Sign In**.

# **Troubleshooting Mobile Services**

The following information should help you troubleshoot any issues with mobile services.

## **How to find my District Code for Mobile Apps**

In PowerSchool:

- 1. On the start page, choose **District** under Setup in the main menu. The District Setup page appears.
- 2. Under Plugins, click **Mobile Registration**. The Mobile Registration page appears.
- 3. If the PowerSchool server is registered with the PowerSource mobile registration server, the Mobile District Code appears. If the PowerSchool server is not registered, dashes appear.

In PowerSchool Student and Parent portal:

- 1. Sign in to PowerSchool Student or Parent portal.
- 2. On the left navigation menu, locate the District Code located at the bottom of the menu. If no code appears, the server is not registered with PowerSource.

In PowerSchool Android Mobile app:

- 1. On the overflow menu, tap **Settings > Disabled Features**.
- 2. Scroll to the bottom of the screen. The District Code appears in parentheses next to the server API version.
- 1. On the sign in screen, tap Where's My District Code?
- 2. Select a method to locate your District Code, or enter the PowerSchool server address manually.

# How to Uninstall and Reinstall the Mobile Apps on Your Device Android

- 1. Depending on the device, apps are uninstalled via the Settings menu > Apps or Application manager.
- 2. Touch the app you want to uninstall, and then touch **Uninstall**.

3. To reinstall the app, download it from the Google Play Store.

#### iOS

- 1. Delete the app on your iPhone by holding on the app's icon for a couple of seconds (hold until the icons start to wiggle), then tap the **x** in the top left corner of the app icon, then tap **Delete**.
- 2. To reinstall the app, download it from the App Store.
