


Math Olympiad Grades 4 - 8



The Math Olympiad program includes two teams, Grades 4 – 6 and Grades 7 – 8. Both teams will begin meeting on **October 18**th **at 7:45a.m. to 8:30a.m.** The Gr. 4 – 6 team is limited to 30 children on a first-come basis; the Gr. 7 – 8 team is limited to 20 participants. Math Olympiad students will enter school at the cafeteria Before Care door. Room locations TBD.

Math Olympiads for Elementary and Middle Schools is a nonprofit foundation that provides math contests and gathers results. The students participate in five contests, the first being held in early November. The contests are done at the school, and the results are reported to Math Olympiad. Last year, 150,000 students from about 5,000 worldwide teams participated in the Olympiads in the elementary and middle school categories. All 50 states and 25 countries were represented.

Students will meet each week to work on practice contests, puzzles, and learn math fun facts, such as a very simple way to know if any number is divisible by 3. These "practice mornings" problems are done in pairs or groups of their own choosing. They are then reviewed by the students and leaders for everyone's benefit. At the contest, each student completes the contest individually within a time frame (30-35 min for 5 problems/puzzles). Each student who participates in 3 or more contests will receive an award in June. If you have other questions, check out Math Olympiads website at www.moems.org
