What is Percussion Ensemble?

Percussion Ensemble is an extra-curricular band activity where students perform both traditional and non-traditional music on garbage cans, buckets, barrels and other “trash” items.

Who is eligible to join?

ANY band member who has completed one full year of curricular band.

(Current 7th and 8th grade band members)

When is Percussion Ensemble?

Percussion Ensemble will meet on Mondays from 2:45 pm – 3:45 pm.

(The after-school activity bus is available for students at the end of rehearsal)

Percussion Ensemble Expectations.

Members are required to attend all scheduled rehearsals in order to maintain membership.

Members must have their own pair of sticks that are only to be used for Percussion Ensemble.

Students will practice their music in a timely manner and come prepared to every rehearsal.

Students need their band binder and Rhythm Book #1 for every rehearsal.



Rehearsals begin **Monday, October 18th**.

Students must have a pair of **Vic Firth MS2** Snare sticks. These can be purchased at Treble Clef Music.
