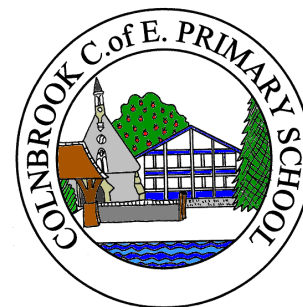

This a fun challenge for everyone to get involved in!

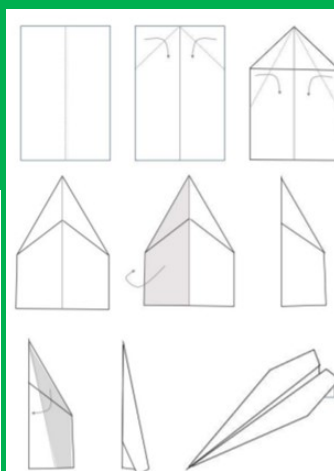
