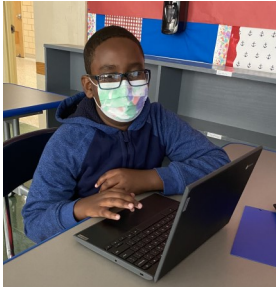

What happens if it doesn't pass?

The district would need to reduce costs by approximately \$450,000. Over 80% of our annual budget supports staffing in all areas. Reduction in staff could result in fewer opportunities for our students, as well as, larger class sizes and would affect our ability to maintain programming.
