HELPFUL TIPS

Staying home sick...When to return to school

If your student misses school with any COVID symptom for more than one day, **or** your student has more than one COVID symptom, they must be cleared by the district nurse before they can return to school. Families are contacted by phone and/or email. Schools do not have authority to clear students. Approval to return to school may take up to 48 hours. Moving forward, our medical coordinators are only able to accept molecular (PCR) COVID 19 tests. Antigen, antibody, or any test performed at home will not be

accepted to return to school. Look for more information via district communication.



LWSD HIGHLY CAPABLE PROGRAM

Highly Capable Services for Elementary and Middle School Students

Lake Washington School District (LWSD) will accept applications for Highly Capable programs from September 8 until 4:00 p.m. on October 1, 2021. Students must live in the Lake Washington School District to apply.

Please note: Parents of first-grade students attending LWSD schools should not apply during this application period. LWSD first-grade students are screened for Highly Capable Programs in their general education classrooms.
