



Message From Principal

I am resending my message from last week. I want to be sure you are all aware of this. PLEASE be sure to read my newsletter. It is important you stay informed to keep your school community safe.

COVID-19 Absence Scenarios

There are various scenarios your student may experience this year as they relate to COVID-19 related absences. **The biggest change is that students who experience one or more COVID-19 symptoms will be required to quarantine until the symptoms are gone and/or they have received a negative COVID-19 test (must be a PCR test).** This requirement will have a greater impact on our school as we enter the cold/flu season. Also starting next week, once your student is either home sick or sent home sick, you will be contacted by a District Contact Tracer. This person will be your point person regarding return to school date/timeline. Please read below so you are aware of the various scenarios that may take place.

- Scenario 1: Student is required to quarantine at home due to being in close contact with someone who was COVID-19 positive and/or being COVID-19 positive themselves.

- This is the most straight forward scenario – the **student will qualify for our COVID-19 support plan** as outlined below and be out for 10-14 days.
- Scenario 2: Student is sent home for having a single COVID-19 symptom and parents *choose not to have* their student take a COVID-19 test.
- Beginning on 9/27 students will be required to quarantine if they have a single COVID-19 symptom. If the family does not want to test their student, the student will be required to quarantine for a minimum of 10 days. **In this case the COVID support plan outlined below WOULD be in effect.**
- Scenario 3: Student is sent home for having a single COVID-19 symptom and parents indicate they *will have* their child take a COVID-19 test.
- Beginning on 9/27 students will be required to quarantine if they have a single COVID-19 symptom. Our COVID Support Plan can take up to 48 hours to get started. If test results take longer than the 48 hours to receive, **the COVID support plan outlined below WOULD be in effect.** The COVID-19 support plan would also go into effect if the student's test came back positive.

COVID-19 Support Plan for Students Required to Quarantine

The following supports will be provided to students who are out multiple days due to a school required multiple day COVID-19 absence.

- A computer will be assigned for the student to use at home
 - Computers will be assigned for pick-up within 48 hours of quarantine

- Teachers will provide 1-2 live “look-in” opportunities each day for students to access via Microsoft Teams
 - Live “look-ins” times/Teams meetings will begin within 48 hours of quarantine
 - Live “look-in” meetings will be approximately 10-15 minutes in length in a core content area, as determined by the grade level team
 - Teams meeting invites will be communicated to families for the live “look-ins” within 48 hours of quarantine
- A weekly plan for learning including assignments and assessments
 - Teachers will communicate with families on these items

What is a live “look-in”?

A live “look-in” is an opportunity for a quarantined student to see/hear the instruction being provided in class. In this scenario the teacher will have provided a Microsoft Teams link for the student to access during a specific time of instruction. The student would hear the teacher’s instruction and see the presentation being shared, but not interact with the teacher/class in any manner. A live “look-in” is not concurrent instruction, meaning there is no back and forth interaction between the student and teacher.

Please help our school stay safe. If your child is sick, keep them home. If your child has any of these symptoms, they must stay home. If they are not kept home, they will be sent home.

Covid Symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 or above (a student does not have to have a fever to have Covid)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Muscle pain or body aches
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
