

Emergency Broadband Benefit Program

EBB is program which provides a TEMPORARY discount on monthly broadband bills for qualifying households.

Do I Qualify?

Yes! All TPSS Students qualify for a temporary discount on monthly broadband bills through their approval for free and reduced lunch services during the 2021-22 school year.

Qualify Through Your Child or Dependent

Any member of your household can make your household eligible. For example, if <u>your child or dependent </u> participates in the Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch Program, your household qualifies for the Emergency Broadband Benefit.

Benefit Qualifying Person

In households that qualify for the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program because a child under the age of 18 in the household participates in the Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch Program or another EBB Program-qualifying program, an adult member of the household must complete the EBB Program application.

On the EBB Program application, the eligible child or dependent should be listed in the Benefit Qualifying Person section.

Children under the age 18 are not eligible to apply for the EBB Program themselves unless the government has declared them an Emancipated Minor.









Begin by filling in guardian information.

Be sure to select that you qualify for the benefit through your child or dependent.

You will be prompted to create a National Verifier account.

Create Your Account Making an account will let us keep your information safe. It will also let you save it and come back to it any time. Choose your username. Choose something you can easily remember. You can also use your email address or your name in some form. Username Choose your password. Make sure it is something you can remember. It has to follow the requirements below. Password Requirements Password At least 8 characters long. ① At least 1 capital letter ① At least 1 number (0-9) Confirm Password At least 1 special character (!@#\$%^&*) Type the same password again. 
To submit an application, you will need to log in to either apply for Lifeline and/or the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program.


Save your login info in a safe place so you can refer to it later. You will need it to sign in during the next step.




To qualify for the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program, we need to know which government assistance program your child or dependent is in or if they qualify based on the acceptable income criteria.



You Qualify for the Emergency Broadband Benefit! Now, it's time to sign up with a provider.

Your application has been approved. If you haven't already done so, your next step is to sign up with a participating internet company by 1/2/2022 (based on US Eastern Time) so you can begin receiving discounted broadband service through the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program.

If you do NOT sign up by 1/2/2022, you will have to reapply for the Emergency Broadband Benefit. Due to the temporary nature of the program, we encourage you to contact a service provider to enroll as soon as you can.

Even if you want to receive the benefit from your current broadband service provider, you still need to contact them to start receiving the benefit.

3. Once Approved, Sign Up with a Provider.

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How to Sign Up with a Provider

1 Contact an <u>internet company</u> to pick a service plan and begin receiving your monthly <u>Emergency Broadband</u> Benefit discount.

If you are interested in a connected device, <u>click here</u> for a list of companies that offer connected devices.

Not all companies participating in the program are offering connected devices. You will need to enroll with a company to receive your broadband AND device benefit.

- Tell the provider that you have been approved by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC).
