Our first month of preschool has been a busy one! The children have spent the past few weeks becoming familiar with a new building, new teachers, and new friends. Our teachers have been busy establishing routines and rules, as this structure provides children with a sense of security, and this security allows them to feel comfortable trying new things.

The themes this month for our three-year-old classes were “All About Me,” feelings and emotions, making friends, and apples. The children were introduced to the letters A, B, and C.

The four-year-old classes focused on fall, the five senses, and apples. A sampling of their activities included tasting a variety of apples, painting with apples, and using apples as a unit of measure to compare lengths. The 4’s have worked with the letters E and F, concentrating on proper letter formation and the letter sounds.

Our students learned that God loves us, and that He created the world and everything in it because of His great love for us. We are learning to pray the Intention of Direction and Grace Before Meals. And, as members of God’s family, we are learning to share God’s love with others here at preschool!
