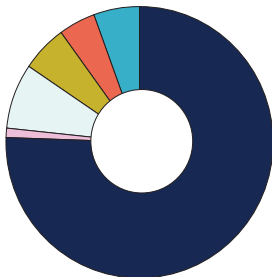

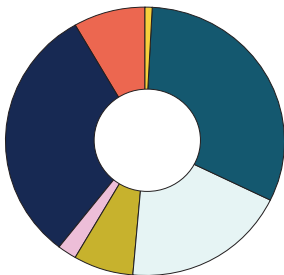

Diverse Student Body



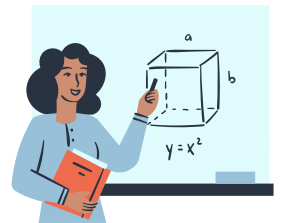
