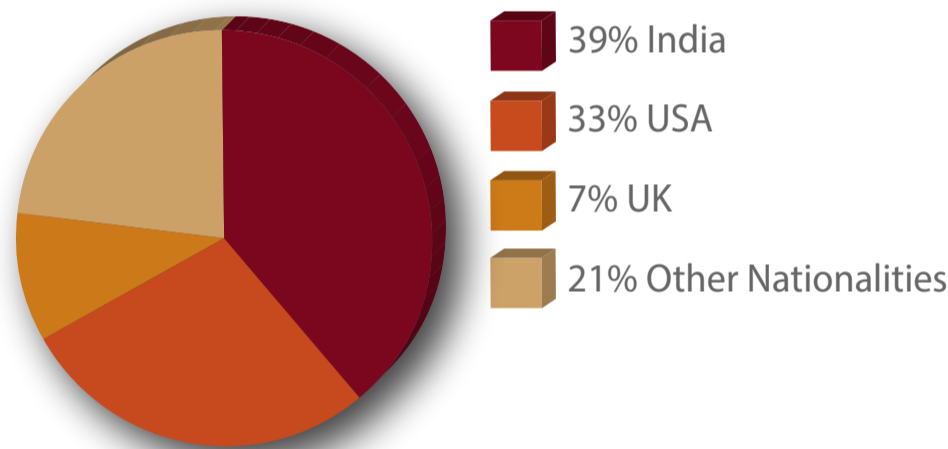
International School of Hyderabad

School & Community

The International School of Hyderabad is a private, non-profit tuition-based day school affiliated with the Office of Overseas Schools of the United States Department of State.

Founded in 1981, the school is on the ICRISAT campus in the northwestern outskirts of the city. It serves students from 22 countries, including USA (33%), India (39%), UK (7%) and all others (21%). The school employs 66 full-time faculty members of 9 different nationalities. Highest degree earned by faculty: All hold bachelors degrees. Additionally, 60% hold masters degrees and 3.5% hold doctorates.

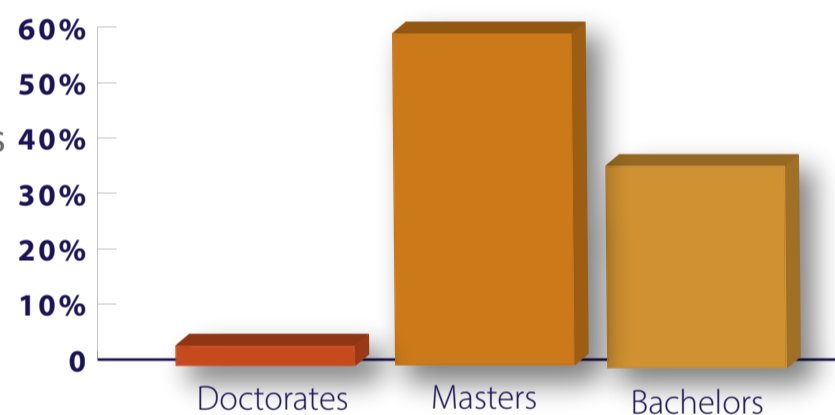

Academic Program

ISH provides a rigorous university preparatory program in which English is the language of instruction. All graduates earn an American High School Diploma. In addition, Grade 11 and 12 students may elect to enroll in the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program while Grade 9 and 10 students study the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) curriculum. The academic year at ISH runs from mid-August to mid-June and follows a semester system.

Covid-19 The ISH Approach

ISH physically closed the campus in March 2020. Thereafter, virtual learning commenced for all students right through the pandemic. ISH used the Zoom platform for delivering lessons.

We started this academic year on August 4th, 2021, scheduling a balanced combination of synchronous virtual lessons and asynchronous independent work, and office hour sessions. In early September, the campus reopened to physically distanced classes.

Some adaptive practices used during this virtual learning period have included:

Oral assessments: These were completed with individual students in all HS subjects throughout the pandemic when physical assessments on campus were not viable. Various platforms have also been used for written assessments of a formal nature.

Virtual Programs: ISH values several learning traditions and routines, and has organized virtual versions, including an IB Art Exhibition, Awards Assemblies (for all secondary grades), 3 Way Conferences, and Program (IB and IGCSE) orientations. Where possible, we have sustained our "normal" learning practices, but adapted their structures through a virtual format.

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Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs)

The educational program at ISH is enhanced by co-curricular activities. These include: Student Government, Model United Nations, Drama, Coding, Instrumental Music Group, The Association for Music in International Schools (AMIS), Choir, Service Club, and the Yearbook. There are 15 activities that students have signed up for this semester; including Model United Nations (MUN), Mock Trial, Vipers' Voice Newspaper, Entrepreneurship, Coding, Cooking, Physical Wellness, and various Service clubs.

During Covid 19:

Co-Curricular activities continue to take place, albeit virtually, including Service Learning, Model United Nations, Mock Trial, as well as various student-led initiatives, such as a Newspaper, Gaming, Entrepreneurship, Cooking, and Physical Wellness.

The school participates in the International Schools Activities Conference in India (ISACI) competitions and festivals. Sports offered include football, basketball, swimming, volleyball (girls) and cricket (boys) and choir.

All ISACI events have been cancelled for Semester I due to Covid-19. Participation will be reviewed in December for Semester 2 activities. One of the constraints of virtual learning has been the restriction of activities normally conducted physically, including sport and service. Student leaders have however, adapted to this situation and created various interactive action related activities through the virtual format. Several new service initiatives have actually strengthened ties with local communities that need support, and students are genuinely leading this process.

Credits are awarded based on the amount of class time per subject (Carnegie Unit).

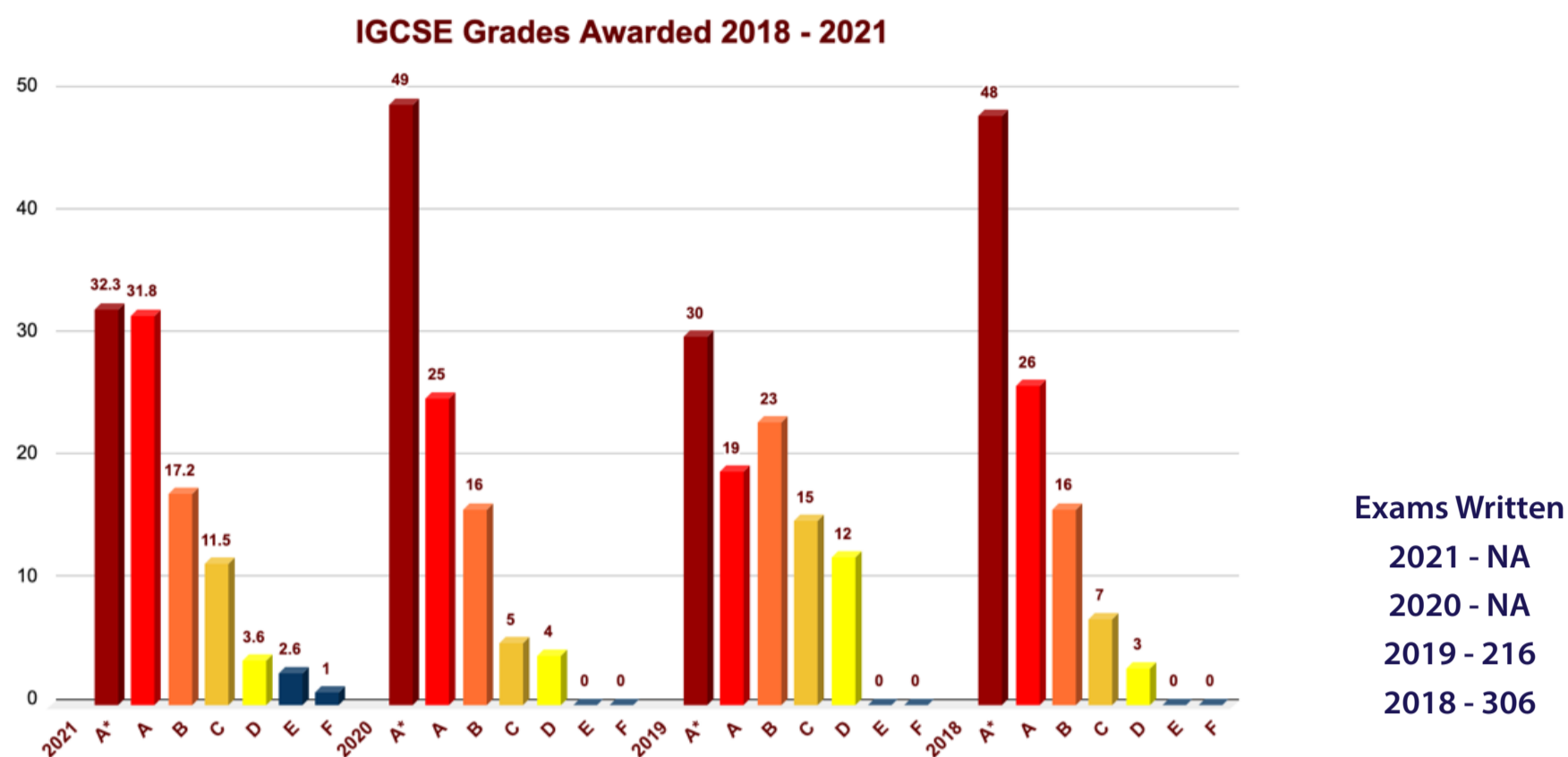
Transcript Notes

In accordance with its policies, ISH DOES NOT rank its students.

1. Gr 9-12 students are graded internally on the 7 - point IB scale, with 7 being the highest and 1 the lowest.
2. Lowest passing grade is a 3.
3. GPAs are calculated on a semester basis using a 7 - point, unweighted scale.
4. ISH HS Diploma classes have no prefix and are of equal rigor to regular college prep classes in the US.
5. All graduates earn the ISH High School diploma.
6. Full IB Diploma candidates are indicated by anticipated IB Diploma date.
7. IB Course candidates are indicated by anticipated Certificate date.
8. Official IGCSE and IB exam results are reported on separate documents.

SAT/ACT Scores

With fewer than 20 students taking these tests, percentiles can be misleading and are therefore not reported here. The test-optional policy adopted by most US universities and colleges has also reduced the number of test-takers.



* In the absence of IGCSE board exams, final grades were based on school assessed grades that followed strict guidelines.
