Mother flew back and that made three.

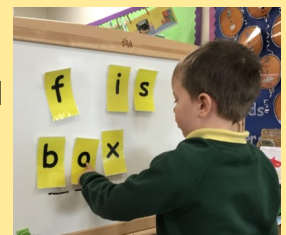
2 little owls with feathers so fine.
