Spotlight on SWAHS

SWAHS offers an alternative learning environment with small class sizes that help students become career and college ready. At SWAHS, all staff members are committed to helping every student feel supported and included. Teachers work to personalize student learning through one-on-one conversations and building relationships.

SWAHS Students have a variety of career readiness options including enrollment in career and technical training at Northeast Metro 916 and earning credits through employment. In addition, students take part in field trips focused on service learning, as well as college and career preparation. SWAHS also offers the Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) program, which helps students develop organizational skills and study habits that they can use to be successful in college.
