
If approved by voters, the estimated tax impact on the average homeowner would be about \$13.16 per month.

The board of Independent School District No. 833 (South Washington County Schools), Minnesota has proposed to revoke the School District's existing referendum revenue authorization of \$1,536.60 per pupil and to replace that authorization with a new authorization of \$1,886.60 per pupil, subject to an annual increase at the rate of inflation. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would be first levied in 2021 for taxes payable in 2022 and applicable for ten (10) years unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by
