

SCHOOL UNIFORM AT THE NEW ENGLISH SCHOOL

Students are expected to wear the appropriate NES uniform in the manner required. When in uniform the students are representing the school. They should be clean, tidy, groomed and appropriate in keeping with the conservative nature of the State of Kuwait.

PRIMARY DEPARTMENT

<p>Girls *Grey and white striped shirt (short sleeves girls may not wear long sleeves rolled up). *Burgundy skirt. *Grey and white striped dress (optional for comfort). White socks. SECONDARY DEPARTMENT

YEARS 7 - 11

*White school shirt purchased from the uniform shop. **If worn, vest/T-shirt should be plain white only.**

*Maroon trousers/skirt. Boys wearing belts should wear standard plain black or mauve belt with a discreet buckle. Students who have skirts/trousers made for whatever reasons must adhere to the pattern from the uniform shop – sketch attached.

*School tie – for formal occasions.

*Maroon jumper with school badge (in cold weather).

Plain, formal, hard leather, black shoes. **Boots/trainer style, ballet style shoes, sandals or canvas shoes are not acceptable** as part of the uniform. Neither are runners, sports or recreational shoes. High platform soles are not safe in school and are therefore prohibited. The purpose is to protect students' feet and provide support. They should have a moulded sole **and heel**. (See examples)

*In colder weather students should wear in addition to the school jumper, blazer or school fleece.

White socks.

Black shoes.

Material of same type is available from shop **only for sizes not stocked. It may be purchased and is to be tailored in the same style as the ready made uniform. See standard design in diagram. **Only this material is permitted.**

SIXTH FORM

Whilst we encourage a sense of self discipline, students are expected to wear the appropriate NES uniform in the manner required, including:

*White school shirt.

*Tie – all students are expected to have and wear a sixth form tie.

*Grey trousers – boys.

*Grey skirts/trousers – girls.

*Blazer – all students are expected to have and wear a blazer.
(Students whose size is not available should buy the material from uniform shop and have it tailored locally according to school design).

*Jumper

Items marked with asterisk (*) are only obtainable from the school uniform shop.

Skirts should be knee length.

Make up and nail varnish are not allowed.

Jewellery is limited to one pair of discreet earrings and a watch.

No chains, bracelets or any other facial jewellery is allowed. This includes jewellery for piercings and if piercings are recent, an unhealed wound, is not an acceptable reason to wear such jewellery.

Hair and beards must be tidy and appropriate to formal attire. As a general rule hair should be clean, well groomed and tidy at all times. In general students should be clean shaven but for those who have a beard it must be clean tidy and styled. An 'unshaven' look is unacceptable.

Girls should have their hair tied back or away from their face. This is for health and safety reasons.

Whilst there is room for some individuality students who fail to meet the required standards will be asked by respective department to conform. Failure to conform may result in disciplinary action.

From 7th August 2016 to June 2017


Sunday to Thursday (inclusive) : 7.30am – 3.30pm

Saturday : 8.00am – 12.00noon


TO THE UNIFORM SHOP

_____ of year _____ has permission to purchase material for skirt/trousers. They must be tailored to the design illustrated below.


SKIRT
