

Finalizing Financial Aid

After Filing the FAFSA

- Review Student Aid Report (SAR)** at fafsa.gov to view comments identifying errors or additional steps you need to take.
Note: To review the SAR, student must login with their FSA ID.
- Make FAFSA Corrections** to update incorrect information or add additional schools.
Note: Any changes to the FAFSA must be signed with the appropriate FSA ID(s) and submitted.
- Register for ScholarTrack** at scholartrack.in.gov and to review your state of Indiana grant eligibility per school.
- Contact each college/university** to which you are accepted and still considering to determine if they need any additional information and respond by each deadline.

DEADLINES

Check with each school about their individual deadlines.

VERIFICATION

The financial aid office may need to confirm some elements of your FAFSA.

STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)

Check your report anytime you correct your FAFSA.
