How to Get Involved

Valley Christian Alumni Ambassadors play a key role as we build our Alumni Association worldwide by creating opportunities for alumni to stay connected to each other and to the school no matter where they live. Our Ambassadors make themselves available to fellow alumni for support, encouragement, friendship, and prayer.

The Commitment: 1 Year (renewed each year)

- In the Spring/Fall: You will receive a list of contacts of our recent high school graduates moving to your area. We ask that you introduce yourself via email to offer support, encouragement and prayer as they transition to a new area.
- We encourage you to organize a meetup or connection event at least once in the calendar school year (Sept-June). The Office of Alumni Ministries will help provide support and resources. For larger networks, one of our leaders would love to attend your event.
- Once a semester, our Director of Alumni Ministries will check in to see how he can support you. There will also be a scheduled Zoom meeting with our broader Ambassador team once a semester.

The Process and Requirements

- Meet with the Director of Alumni Ministries via zoom.
