MSR Bus Schedule | 2021-2022

Lead Mine Campus (LMC) Bus

- Morning: depart LMC at 7:30 a.m.; arrive BCC by 8 a.m.
- Afternoon: BCC at 3:15 p.m.; arrive LMC at 3:35

Brier Creek Campus (BCC) Bus

- Morning: depart BCC at 7:45 a.m.; arrive LMC by 8:15 a.m.
- Afternoon: depart LMC at 3 p.m.; arrive BCC at 3:25 p.m.

Important Information

- Please contact your teacher/advisor and bus driver before 7 a.m. if your child will be absent and not riding the morning bus.
- Buses leave promptly at the times designated. Please arrive at 5-10 minutes prior to departure time.
- Supervision of the student is the responsibility of the parent or guardian until the student boards the bus.
- Students may not be left in the parking lot without supervision at any time.
 - LMC students with BCC bus riders may head to their classrooms for Before-School Care.
- A parent or guardian must be present to collect his or her student from LMC and/or BCC.

In the event of a late pick up or drop off, efforts will be made to contact you via text.

Health and Safety Bus Protocols

Health Protocols

- Buses will operate at reduced capacity. Families must sign up in advance as space is limited. No drops-in will be allowed.
- Students will sit in designated spaces to comply with physical distancing guidelines.
- Students and staff will be required to wear face masks while riding the bus.
- Buses will be cleaned and disinfected regularly prior to morning and afternoon trips.

Bus Safety

Please review these bus safety guidelines with your child to help keep everyone safe on our buses.

- Students should remain seated at all times with hands and arms inside the vehicle.
- Seatbelts should be fastened one person per seatbelt.
- Noise level should be such as to not distract the driver.
- There should be no throwing of objects or other disruptive behavior.
- Exits and aisles shall not be blocked with equipment or backpacks.
- Students should be mindful not to leave any trash on the bus and/or engage in any activity that could damage the bus and/or its seats and windows.

Passengers should enter and leave the vehicle under the direction of a staff member and/or driver. If the vehicle makes an emergency stop, passengers should follow directions of a staff member and/or driver.
