WE'VE GOT THIS

Staff and students help keep health care workers safe

Faculty and students from Stillwater Area Public Schools are using district 3D printers to help fight the COVID-19 pandemic.

When they heard about shortages of protective gear among health care workers, staff from the district tech department jumped into action and set up 3D print stations at home.

Staff and students are making face shields by combining 3D printed plastic headbands with transparencies that were used with old overhead projectors. The face shield is meant for health care workers to use as an extra layer of protection over N95 masks.

They're also printing "ear savers" - a plastic device worn at the back of the head to hold face mask straps instead of behind the ears which can cause discomfort and even bleeding.





They have cranked out more than 1,000 ear savers and 200 face shields. The items have been given to Lakeview and Regions hospitals, the Minneapolis Police Department, several long term care facilities, as well as one of our own district custodians.

Workers at Regions Hospital who received a package of ear savers were thrilled. One nurse said, "It was like Christmas here when I brought the bag in."

Going the distance for our students

Attending school may look differently for our students as a result of the COVID-19 quarantine, but thanks to the hard work and innovation of our teachers, quality learning is still happening.

When Governor Walz announced schools across the state would be closing to slow the spread of COVID-19, our teachers had just a few days to design an entirely different system to teach. Many of them had to first become students learning new technology and online platforms to connect with kids and families. In just a week's time, our teachers and administrators not only determined what learning should look like from a distance, they also ensured students had access to the technology and the social and emotional support they would need along the way.

"I know that I have become a better teacher through this crisis," said Laura Hammond, a high school language arts teacher. "I believe that we have learned from each other, which is beneficial — it's important for students to see adults learning and growing."

DISTANCE LEARNING

A new way to teach and to learn

By definition from the Minnesota Department of Education, distance learning means students have to have access to appropriate educational materials and receive daily instruction by a teacher. In Stillwater, we've also made personal connections an essential part of our plan. Even before distance learning officially began, our teachers made phone calls to each and every one of their students to see how they were doing, ask what needs they had, and reassure them that we're all in this together.

Those personal connections have continued as teachers not only support student learning, but also help identify kids in need of additional mental health support or guide families toward resources to access food or financial assistance.

Teachers have also gotten very creative in how they are providing instruction to their students. Instead of simply sending out worksheets or assigning a project, teachers are working hard to engage with students one-on-one and in small groups. Many teachers are creating videos and presentations to introduce students to new concepts, and then offering one-on-one meetings throughout the week to provide further clarification or assistance, if needed Others are utilizing discussion boards or video chats to allow students to interact with each other and discuss concepts.



"There was concern that this kind of a model might serve as an excuse for many students to disengage from school, but we have not found this to be the case," said Rob Bach, principal of Stillwater Area High School. "On the whole, our students have been resilient and demonstrated a great desire to stay connected as Pony learners."



CARING FOR OUR KIDS

Our students may not be in our buildings, but they are still very much under our care! We're honored to walk alongside families during this time to ensure our students have everything they need to help them learn and keep them healthy and strong.

Personal connections

Our teachers are personally connecting with each child and family on a regular basis to ensure that they have what they need to engage in distance learning. Not only are teachers providing lessons and providing one-on-one help, they're also checking in on basic needs like access to food and mental health support. Some have even made socially-distanced house calls to send messages of love to students.

Feeding our kids

Each week our food services staff is preparing and distributing more than 10,000 meals to our kids. We're not just talking PB&Js, either. The team has developed a special menu with a variety of healthy and delicious breakfast and lunch items. Families pick up an entire week's worth of food each Monday at 14 distribution sites located throughout the district.

Emergency childcare

Each day we're providing care to more than 40 children of emergency workers. This emergency childcare ensures our community's most essential workers in areas like health care, law enforcement, and grocery stores can do their jobs to serve all of us.

Family support

Staff aren't the only ones impacted by distance learning, so we've developed a variety of resources to help parents navigate their new role. Our staff has created step-by-step training videos and online presentations to help parents connect with Seesaw and Schoology, and provided sample distance learning schedules and checklists specific to parents and students.

We've also created several parent support groups through Community Education, and offered a weekly webinar series with strategies and tips to navigate distance learning. We're posting positive messages of support and videos of encouragement from teachers, too, which can be found on Facebook.com/Stillwater834.

Mental health support

Our social workers and school counselors have put together resources to help students and families deal with the stress and challenges of COVID-19. The Support for Families link on our website provides a variety of resources to help families access mental health support as well as provide for basic needs - such as food and financial support. Counselors are also continuing to provide personalized support virtually including individual student meetings/ check-ins, student groups, family meetings and more

Technology

We've provided - and in some cases personally delivered - more than 500 Chromebooks and 150 HotSpot internet connections to students without access to ensure they can continue learning.

Community partners

Lakeview Hospital, Washington County, the Greater Stillwater Area Chamber of Commerce, Valley Outreach, Family Means, Youth Service Bureau and our local faith community have been working closely with us to find creative ways to serve our students and families.

Student recognized for excellence in theatre

State looks to Stillwater schools as positive example for distance learning

The effort to pull off distance learning in

Stillwater Area Public Schools has gained attention at the state level. Stillwater Area High School was one of three schools to be featured as part of a presentation to educators across the state of Minnesota on the importance of relationships in engaging students in learning — whether in person or at a distance. Stillwater was selected because of its work with the BARR (Building Assets, Reducing Risk) program, which helps to build connections with our students. SAHS staff presented during the state-wide distance learning planning and training days in early May, which Governor Walz ordered as a way to help educators finish the school year strong.

High school named one of the best in the state and nation

Stillwater Area High School has once again been named one of the top high schools in the nation and state. U.S. News and World Report analyzed data from more than 24,000 public high schools and ranked SAHS in the top 10% in the country and top 3% in Minnesota.

The rankings are based on six factors, including college readiness, curriculum, math and reading assessments, and how underserved students perform.

Student earns international recognition

Milan Jostes has been named an International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF) Finalist. He's one of only about 1,800 high school students from around the world to earn the honor.

The Stillwater Area High School junior was recognized after placing first in the Twin Cities Regional Science Fair. Jostes' FourS 2.0 (School Safety and Security System) project uses cell phones and internet access to regulate who can enter a school. By using the United States Secret Service Threat Assessment Model, he was able to implement a bag check system that is unbiased and will reduce the amount of prohibited items in schools, thereby making schools safer.



Four selected as 2020 Distinguished Alumni

Four individuals will be honored for a lifetime of distinction after graduating from Stillwater Area High School. They will join nearly 100 others who have been named Distinguished Alumni since the award was first given in 1987.
