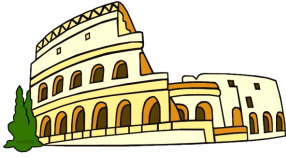
Marie Curie

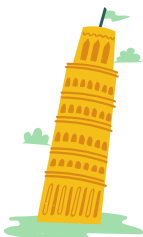

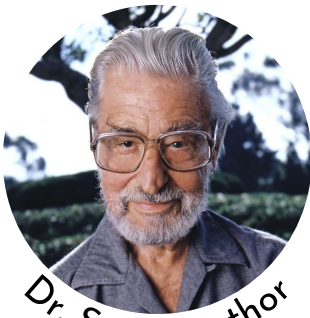
