Community and School: -

Almaty International School is a member of Quality Schools International (QSI), a consortium of non-profit college-preparatory schools following an American-style curriculum. QSI has 35 schools in 29 countries and 5 continents. Headquarters is located in Malta. AIS was founded in 1993 and is affiliated with the U.S. Dept. of State Office of Overseas Schools. AIS is a private, non-profit international school with an American college preparatory curriculum. English is the language of instruction.

Philosophy: -

Almaty International School believes in a personal approach to instruction leading to mastery within a positive and enjoyable learning environment. It offers a challenging academic curriculum for students age 3 through 18. Studies are tailored to meet the needs of each individual student.

Covid 19 Impact: -

During the COVID 19 pandemic, Almaty International school, following the Republic of Kazakhstan's guidelines, was able to finish 2019-20 with distance learning. The 20-21 school year began with distance learning, but the students were able to move to face-to-face learning by the 3rd quarter.

Accreditation: -

Quality Schools International is fully accredited by the Middle States
Association of Colleges and Schools.

Faculty:

Almaty International School employs one Director, two Directors of Instruction, one Secondary Counselor, one Elementary Counselor, one Athletic Director, 48 full-time foreign teachers, 16 Russian, Kazakh, and world Language teachers, plus many support staff including office staff and IT support.

Graduation Requirements: -

Academic Diploma: The minimum requirements for the Academic Diploma are 240 QSI units (24 Carnegie) in the following areas of concentration:

- English Literacy (80 units)
- Math (30 units)
- Science (30 units)
- Cultural Studies (40 units)
- PE/Wellness (20 units)
- World Languages (20 units)
- Fine Arts (10 units)
- Electives (minimum 10 units)

The academic Diploma provides a rigorous course of study for those intending to matriculate to university. Students who successfully complete at least 2 AP courses as well as all above requirements will earn an Academic Diploma with Honors.

Curriculum: -

Almaty International School follows an American college preparatory curriculum including Advanced Placement (AP) classes. In addition to its scholastic goals, AIS endeavors to provide its students with a specialized program including both Russian and Kazakh language and culture. To guide students toward healthy lifestyles and good citizenship, QSI curriculum includes instruction in Success Orientations-seven areas of characted development.

General Diploma: The General Diploma is available to students who experience English language difficulties, time restraints, or other challenges that make it impractical to pursue an academic diploma. The minimum requirements for the General Diploma are 220 QSI units in the following areas:

- English Literacy (50 units)
- Math (20 units)
- Science (20 units)
- Cultural Studies (30 units)
- PE/Wellness (20 units)
- World Languages (20 units)
- Fine Arts (10 units)
- Electives (50 units)

AP Capstone Diploma: AIS offers this for students who successfully complete AP Seminar and AP Research with a 3 or better along with 4 other AP exams of choice.

Enrollment:

Almaty International School encompasses Pre-K through Secondary IV (grade 12) with a current enrollment of 400. The middle school enrollment is 76 and there are 137 students in the high school. AIS represents 25 different nationalities with 14% being students of the United States.

Credits:

Year-long courses are divided into 10 units, with 10 units equal to 1 Carnegie Unit. Students receive credit only for units mastered at an A or B level. Secondary transcripts show the number of units completed for each course per school year and the average grade for the units completed in each course. The transcript is a living document with units added as completed.

Grading System: -

Teachers evaluate mastery of each essential unit with an A or B. B represents mastery at a sufficiently high level, and A represents mastery at a sufficiently high level with the student consistently demonstrating hig her orderking thinking skills. Mediocre or poor work, resulting in Cs and Ds is not accepted, as students are required to engage in a unit until they achieve mastery. Students who master a unit with a B evaluation may attempt to demonstrate a higher level of mastery within a given time period. to achieve the A. There are no quarter, semester, or term evaluation periods; student performance is assessed on each unit of study as they are completed.
