

## Middle School Plan for Virtual Learning

In Ascension Parish Middle Schools, all teachers and students have their own Chromebook device equipped with access to the Internet and Google Suite. Teachers and students bring home their devices daily. In order to continue to provide middle school students with access to high quality curriculum and assignments through a virtual learning environment, Ascension Parish Middle Schools will communicate the following expectations to teachers, students, and parents:

For students without Internet access: Schools will provide paper copies of assignments and utilize School Messenger to communicate with these students.
