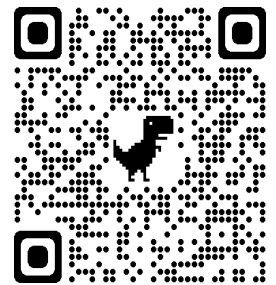

Anointing of the Sick: at all Masses Oct. 16-17 Sat 4pm, Sun 8am, 10am, 12pm, 5pm

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick gives the grace of the Holy Spirit to those who are sick. This grace helps the whole person, not only to bear the suffering but also to quiet anxiety, dissipate fear, and inspire confidence in God and acceptance of his will. When the Sacrament is celebrated communally, those who are sick, experiencing the frailty of old age, recovering from addictions, or preparing for a serious medical procedure, come before the community in faith to be anointed with the Oil of the Infirm and prays over them. The community, in a solemn prayer of faith, intercedes for those who are being anointed and prays for healing of body, mind, and soul.

The special graces of God in the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick have these effects in those who open their lives to God:

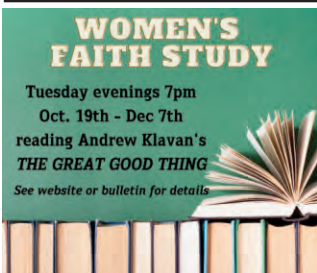
- The uniting of the sick person to the passion of Christ

Parish Updates & Events

AEDs on OLGC Campus—An AED (automated external defibrillator) is a lightweight and battery powered piece of medical equipment that potentially can be lifesaving. An AED is used to treat ventricular fibrillation, the most common cause of sudden cardiac arrest. Anyone is a potential victim of sudden cardiac arrest, man or woman, young or old. Survival of a sudden cardiac arrest is related to how quickly a victim is defibrillated. AED units are seen in most public places such as libraries, swimming pools, airports, shopping malls...and OLGC.

OLGC has six AED units located in the following areas:

- * Narthex of the Church (close to De Sales Hall)
- * DeSales Hall lower level in the preschool, Room E
- * St. Joseph Center (in the stairwell going up to the second floor)
- * School outside the Health Clinic (close to the main entrance)
- * School outside the gym
- * School, 2nd floor, by the elevator close to the resource and math rooms

These AED units are only lifesaving if people are trained in CPR and AED use. Trained responders are the key to potentially saving another person's life. Consider enrolling in a CPR/AED class soon!



OLGC Music Ministry: The Church teaches us that music at Mass is normative. One of the hardest things about the pandemic when we first came back was that there was little, or no music allowed to be sung. Something was missing. But when the restrictions began to lessen, and music was once again allowed, we decided to work to unify our sung prayer – same opening and closing hymns/songs, and the same sung Mass setting at all the English Masses. This has provided for our music to be a singular prayer while expressed in different ways. Many have commented that they prefer this type of structure to the Mass.



The Music Ministries at OLGC strive to pray and to praise God through music while assisting our worshipping assembly to have "conscious, active and full participation" as called for by the church. We have many talented people, young and old, amateur, and professional serving the OLGC community. But there is a need for more (you) to join and get involved in the music ministry. As we move forward, we invite you to share your gift with the community by joining one of our music ministries. HOSPICE CARE CONT'D. – This is the second part of a three-part series on hospice care and Medicare. So, depending on your terminal illness and related conditions, the plan of care your hospice team creates can include any or all of these services: Doctors' nursing and medical services, durable medical equipment for pain relief and symptom management, medical supplies such as bandages or catheters, drugs for pain management, aide and homemaker services, physical and occupational therapy services as well as speech-language pathology services, social services, dietary counseling, spiritual and grief cocounseling for you and your family, and short-term

patient care for pain and symptom management. This care must be in a Medicare-approved facility, such as a hospice facility, hospital, or skilled nursing facility that contracts with the hospice you'll be using.

It also covers inpatient respite care, which is care you get in a Medicare-approved facility (such as an inpatient facility, hospital, or nursing home) so that your usual caregiver (like a family member or friend) can rest. Your hospice provider will arrange this for you. You can stay up to 5 days each time you get respite care. You can get respite care more than once, but only on an occasional basis. Any other services Medicare covers to manage your pain and other symptoms related to your terminal illness and related conditions, as your hospice team recommends, are also covered. Medicare does not cover room and board when you get hospice care in your home or other facility where you live, such as in a nursing home.

Hospice care is usually given in your home but may also be covered in a hospice inpatient facility. Original Medicare will still pay for covered benefits for any health problems that aren't part of your terminal illness and related conditions, but this is unusual. When you choose hospice care, you decide you no longer want care to cure your terminal illness and/or your doctor determines that efforts to cure your illness aren't working. Once you choose hospice care, your hospice benefit will usually cover everything you need. (Conclusion next week: what Medicare **won't** cover.)

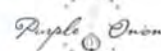
