Use the checklists below to compare our online programs to determine which platform best meets the needs of your student.

The decision to enroll a student with disabilities within either of the online programs is an IEP team decision.*

***NOTE:** The structure of Home-Based Virtual Learning may be the best choice for students with IEP needs and services, as there are more opportunities for support.

OPTION # 1

✓	Home-Based Virtual Learning
	Student can participate in instruction during regular school hours & class times and submits assignments as directed by the teacher. Learning occurs in “real school time.”
	Student has difficulty reading and comprehending text.
	Student learns best with the ability to receive in-class instruction and support.
	Student will benefit from staying in a daily routine and having a teacher track progress.
	Student prefers to receive “live” instruction from an APSB teacher from their home-based school.
	Student prefers to participate in a classroom setting with other students present.

OPTION # 2

✓	Blended Learning Program
	Student will complete assignments in a flexible setting and time frame as designed by the student and parent.
	Student is a good, thorough reader with good comprehension skills.
	Student is a self-learner and is able to stay on task and work independently.
	It is not necessary for the student to learn from live instruction or “real time” instruction daily.
	Student learns well through watching video lessons and applying understanding to quizzes & tests.
	Student is self-motivated, has good time management skills, and doesn’t mind working alone.
