### **SAT & PSAT – WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 13**

All students will take a version of the SAT. Seniors take the actual SAT, Juniors & Sophomores the PSAT/NMSQT, and Freshmen take the PSAT 8/9. You must be at school by 7:45am. Your test will be over sometime between 11:30am and noon. Please make arrangements to be picked up then. Please check your email from Ms. Hoekzema on Monday, October 11 for what room you will report to.

### **AFTER SCHOOL**
