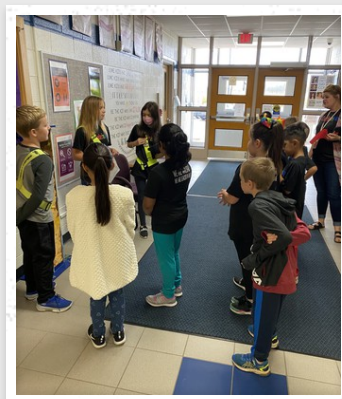


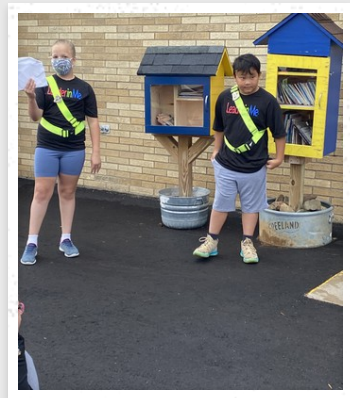
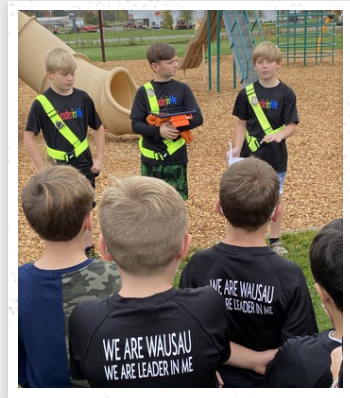
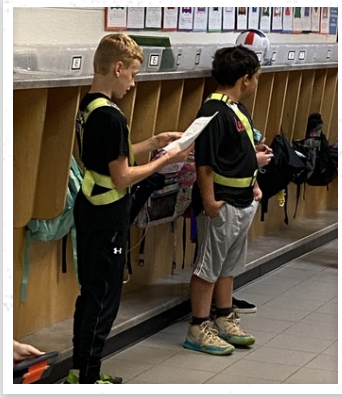
LION'S VOLLEYBALL

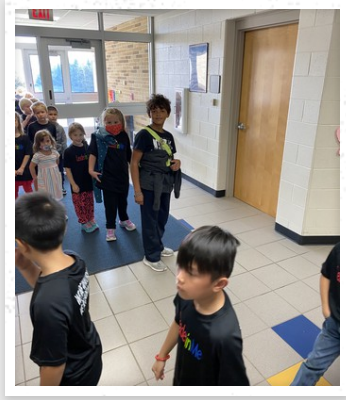

STUDENTS LEADING STUDENTS!

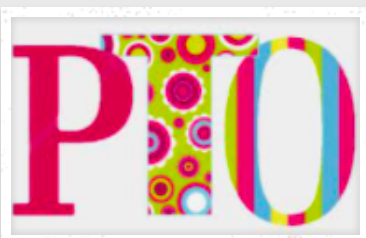
