The position:

We are looking for an experienced Japanese language teacher who can teach IB MYP Japanese language acquisition classes in our Middle and High Schools, with the potential for some DP classes in the future also. Experience with IB MYP and/or DP lesson planning, teaching philosophy, and assessment models will therefore be a strong advantage. The ability to adapt content and teaching practices for different levels of ability is essential.

Supervisor:

The Japanese language teacher reports to the OIS Middle and High School Principal.

Salary and Benefits:

We offer a competitive rate calculated by the number of classes taught and including holidays. A commuting allowance is also paid. The position is ideally suited to a local resident or a travelling spouse, not in need of relocation, allowances or other benefits that come with a full-time position.

The number of teaching hours will be confirmed prior to each term and is subject to change based on the needs of the curriculum. Typically, there will be about 12 hours a week of Japanese language acquisition.

This is a year-long contract with the possibility of renewal based on the agreement of both parties.
