## Available Vaccines:

### **Quadrivalent**

For persons 6 months and older • the “regular” flu shot

### **High Dose Quadrivalent**

For persons 65 years and older

Studies have shown that the high-dose flu vaccine is safe and more effective for seniors than the regular flu shot

### **Flublok**

For persons 18 years and older • Suitable for adults with egg allergies

### **FluMist**

For healthy children 2 - 18 years • the nasal spray vaccine • limited supply
