

10.13.21 - Community Council Meeting Notes

Agenda Items:

1. **Welcome** – Paulynn Hacking welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2. **Dance Attendance Update** – Mr. Swanson reviewed the new District Dance Policy and explained the new policy of High School Students ONLY. One student must be a Farmington student and the other must have their school ID.
3. **Dress Code** – Student concerns about dress have been given to Mr. Swanson. Mr. Swanson asked for suggestions from the council. Becky Dunleavy asked the question, “How do you want teachers to handle the dress code?” It was expressed that teachers want students in class. It was also suggested to use the wording as “reasonable vs unreasonable” dress. Shalice Larsen brought up that if we put out a survey we are going to get a wide variety of responses. It was suggested that the survey be a closed answer survey with “agree/disagree” questions. The current dress code will be sent out to the council to review before the next meeting. Feedback from the council will come back in 2 weeks so that a survey can be sent out to the community. The need for the survey is to get clarification on the dress code. It was suggested that the survey be for more feedback rather than policy change. The survey will be sent to the student body as well as parents.
4. **Covid Update** – Mr. Sims gave a review of the current Covid protocol in testing and a current count of Covid cases within the school. The protocol to testing the school if the threshold is met.
5. **Citizenship Policy Review** – The current policy was reviewed by Mr. Sims and a question of eligibility came up. It was explained that non-made up U’s in citizenship would result in the athlete being ineligible to participate.
6. **9th Grade Participation** – The additional item was proposed by Christy Mortensen. Mr. Swanson explained the new policy as passed by the Davis School Board. 9th graders are now eligible to play at any high school as long as they are accepted with a variance.
