ABOUT / Canadian Academy has been serving Kobe's international community since 1913. Our programs reflect the changing needs of our students and ensure the development of a global perspective that recognizes the special opportunities of being an international student in Japan.

PROGRAMS AND DIPLOMAS / Canadian Academy maintains an advanced college/university preparatory educational program in the English language. Our pathways in the High School Program are as follows:

- > CA Diploma with full International Baccalaureate Diploma
- > CA Diploma with International Baccalaureate Courses
- > CA High School Diploma

GRADING SYSTEM / In Grades 11 and 12, all classes are taught as IB DP classes. This includes classes for students who are not pursuing the IB DP. CA does not weight GPA and does not rank students or provide percentile/decile information. Students are assessed on a 1–7 scale, and CA does not provide a GPA. CA does not compare IB grades with grading systems from other schools or countries.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS / Students must meet the below requirements to earn our accredited US High School Diploma. The typical student earns 27 credits.

We are an IB World School and offer the International Baccalaureate Primary Years (PYP), Middle Years (MYP) and Diploma Program (DP).



CLASS OF 2022 GRADE DISTRIBUTION (GRADE 11) /

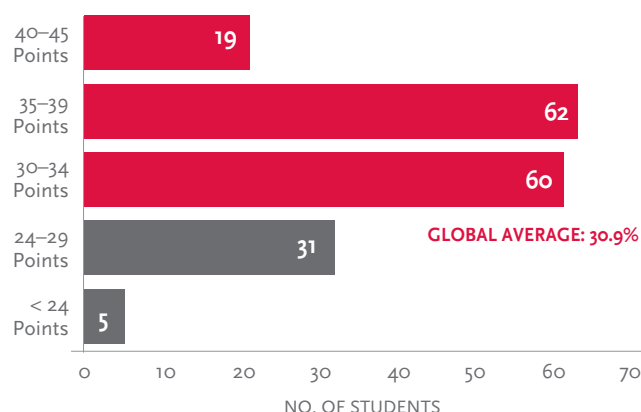
