

RECIPROcity OF ACADEMIC CREDIT

To determine whether students transferring into the district have met district course requirements, the Superintendent or designee shall establish procedures to evaluate the comparability of courses and/or students' understanding of course content. Such procedures shall include methods for determining the number of years of school attendance, the specific courses completed by the student and the value of credits earned.

The district shall accept, for full or partial credit, coursework satisfactorily completed by students while attending an accredited public school, a juvenile court school or nonpublic nonsectarian school or agency. Partial credit shall be granted by the receiving school on the same basis to students whose course of study cannot be aligned or continued.

Foster youth, homeless or unaccompanied youth, migrant students, students of military families and students placed in a juvenile court school, who exit the Oxnard Union High School District prior to the end of a grading period, will be issued partial credit based on the number of days enrolled and the course grade to date.

- 17-23 days = 1 credit per subject
- 24-30 days = 1.5 credit per subject
- 31-37 days = 2 credits per subject
- 38-44 days = 2.5 credits per subject
- 45-51 days = 3 credits per subject
- 52-58 days = 3.5 credits per subject
- 59-65 days = 4 credits per subject
- 66-72 days = 4.5 credits per subject
- 73+ days = 5 credits per subject

With the approval of the Principal and Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, partial credit may be considered for other students exiting the Oxnard Union High School District.
