Supplemental Special Education Services (SSES) is:

SSES gives a **\$1,500 one-time online grant** to parents of eligible students served by special education who are enrolled in a Texas public school. Families can use this money to purchase educational goods and services for their student.

SSES Eligibility Criteria:

This new eligibility criteria will begin on **November 1**st, **2021.**

To be eligible for the SSES grant, students must currently be:

- » enrolled in a Texas public school,
- » enrolled in PreK 12th grade, and
- a student with a disability served through Special Education.
