Scholarship Opportunity for Washington State University (WSU)

If your student is planning to attend Washington State University next year and has a 3.6 GPA or higher, we encourage them to apply for the Regents Scholars Program. This scholarship recognizes students for their academic potential, leadership, and community service. Two students from each high school in Washington will be awarded a minimum of \$4,000 per year for four years. To be considered for this scholarship, students need to submit the [online application](#) by 2:15 on Tuesday, October 12th.
