# **Timeline for Progress Reports/Report Cards**

#### **First Quarter**

9/1/21 – 10/29/21 Progress reports will be mailed home. First Semester 9/1/21 – 1/27/22 Report cards will be mailed home the third week of February. Third Quarter 1/31/22 – 4/15/22 Progress reports will be mailed home the following week. Second Semester 1/31/22 – 6/16/22 Report cards will be mailed home the following week. Grades given at the end of first and second semesters will be permanent grades on the high school

transcript.

### Scholarship Opportunity for Washington State University (WSU)

If your student is planning to attend Washington State University next year and has a 3.6 GPA or higher, we encourage them to apply for the Regents Scholars Program. This scholarship recognizes students for their academic potential, leadership, and community service. Two students from each high school in Washington will be awarded a minimum of \$4,000 per year for four years. To be considered for this scholarship, students need to submit the <u>online application</u> by 2:15 on Tuesday, October 12th.
