The Howard P. Rawlings Guaranteed Access (GA) Grant is a need-based grant that provides postsecondary financial assistance to eligible in-state students currently enrolled as high school seniors who will complete a college preparatory program or a student who has obtained a General Educational Development Diploma (GED), and is under the age of 26. All applicants must meet certain income requirements as described below for the 2020-2021 application cycle for consideration of the GA grant.

AWARD

The amount of the GA Grant equals 100 percent of the student's financial need and a student may receive an award for up to \$19,100.

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Maryland State Financial Aid Application (MSFAA), if ineligible to complete the FAFSA but are eligible to receive in-state tuition on or before March 1, 2020.
- 2. List at least one Maryland college or university on the FAFSA or MSFAA.
- Submit all documents (if required) to MHEC by April 1, 2020.
