## ASSOCIATE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES Minimum of 60 Credits

The Associate of Arts and Sciences Degree in Liberal Studies provides a student with a broad-based understanding of either the humanities or social sciences disciplines. This program offers a multidisciplinary approach where both degree tracks and emphasis courses are selected on the basis of the student's interests. A graduate from this program could pursue careers in the humanities such as communications, visual and performing arts, journalism, entertainment services, and tourism industries or in the social sciences such as government and public administration, health science, law, and public safety. This degree also allows a student to pursue a baccalaureate degree in a variety of fields by completing the required courses at CMN and finishing his/her Junior- and Senior-level classes at a four-year college or university.
