- Daniel reported Dr. Soumakian introduced the new Leadership Goal to the group at the last ODC meeting.
- Dr. Soumakian reported he visited all the district's ASB classes to discuss the role of ASB leadership and is recommending that one student leadership goal be part of the Distributive Leadership model.
- 9-B Board Report: *Administrative Intern Program* Dr. Rocky Valles, Assistant Superintendent-Human Resources provided a report on the Administrative Intern Program via PowerPoint presentation. Dr. Valles stated the program objective is to build administrative capacity in the District by providing our interns with practical administration experiences; and, he reviewed the qualifications, responsibilities, and guidelines.
- 9-C Board Recommendation: *Education Design Committee* Mr. William Dabbs, Assistant Superintendent-Educational Services presented the Ad Hoc Committee's recommendation to Trustees. Mr. Dabbs announced that the Committee made a presentation at the last Board meeting and has come to a strong consensus for construction of new high Comprehensive/Academy school at Bell Ranch property to serve Camarillo and Somis for 93010, 93012, and 93066 zip codes, with provisions for a lottery if there is unused capacity. The school will offer full academic and athletic opportunities for students; generalized courses of study rather than specific classes; arts media, and entertainment; engineering and design; and biomedical technology and services. Mr. Dabbs stated the Committee will prepare an official letter of recommendation for the Board's consideration that will be presented at a future meeting.

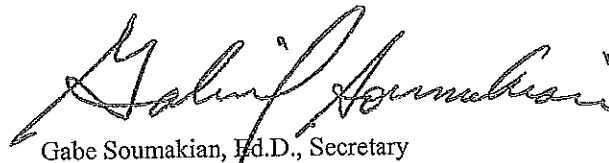

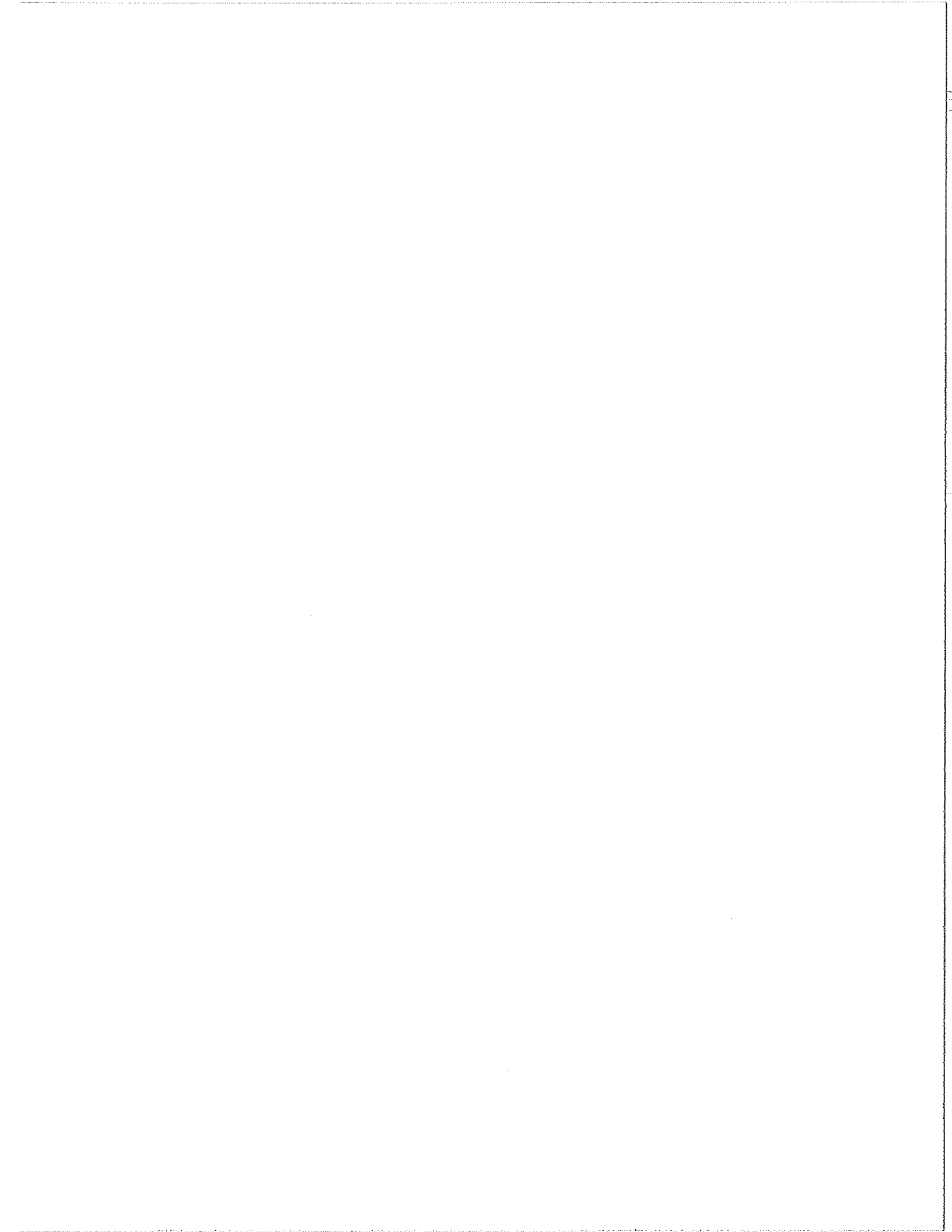
