The Board reconvened at 6:30 p.m. President Valles reported no action was taken.

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AUDIENCE TO ADDRESS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

Nine public speakers addressed the board to express concerns regarding the resignation of Dr. Adrian Palazuelos, Principal of Hueneme High School. They asked that Trustees readdress the issue of reinstating Dr. Palazuelos as principal.

One speaker asked that handrails be installed on the HHS bleachers to accommodate those persons with disabilities.

One speaker offered to provide the OHS Mock Trial team a copy of a certified transcript of real court proceedings.

A representative from OFTSE said it was disappointing to hear that at the board's last meeting, Trustees approved the recommendation to release nine counselors. The speaker stated a decision to lay-off staff members may be prudent when safeguarding against future trouble, but is it necessary. The speaker requested that the Board keep in mind that the district has a substantial reserve, this is a well-managed, solvent district, and all indications point to the fact that our district is in an anomalous position – we are really, really quiet solvent. The speaker asked Trustees, when the time is appropriate, to dig into using the general and categorical reserves.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORTS:

Board Presentation: *Counselor Masterplan*

Ms. Mutz provided a background on how the Counselor Masterplan was developed, over the last four years, by Rebecca Buettner, Director of Assessment and Accountability. Counselors provided information on what their main responsibilities were, critical tasks that were required, and supervision process. Mrs. Buettner, via a PowerPoint presentation provided an overview of the Counselor Master Plan. The Masterplan is a living document; it helps counselors evaluate their programs, provides a template for future Intervention Programs, holds counselors accountable and contains numerous resources.

On a personal note, Mrs. Buettner stated this would be her last presentation to the board and it was a pleasure working in the district. Trustees thanked her for a very comprehensive plan and wished her well in her retirement.

Progress Report: *Facilities Master Plan*

Randy Winton, Assistant Superintendent-Educational Services and Stephen McFarland, Director of Maintenance, Operations and Transportation via a PowerPoint presentation provided an update of the Facilities Master Plan that have been completed and/or near completion, and reported plans and bids are starting to come in for several projects.
