MINUTES FOR THE REGULAR BOARD MEETING

April 8, 2009

1. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Oxnard Union High School District was called to order by President Stocks at 5:00 p.m., April 8, 2009, in the District Office Board Room, 220 South K Street, Oxnard, California.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mr. Randy Winton led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Dr. Dunlap requested that Amelia Gaxiola's name be removed from Consent Item 10-A.

Concerns were expressed by Trustees regarding the process for building a Board Agenda:

- Can Trustees request an item be placed on the agenda.
- Who determines which items are approved for placement.
- Is there a Board Policy outlining the Board agenda process.
- Is the public allowed to place an item on the agenda.

Dr. Dunlap responded yes, a Trustee can request that an item be placed on the agenda; the Board President, Vice President and Administrative Staff determine which items are placed on the agenda; the District follows the CSBA guidelines for agendas; and, yes, the public is allowed to submit agenda items.




