# MINUTES FOR THE REGULAR BOARD MEETING October 14, 2009

#### ROLL CALL:

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Oxnard Union High School District was called to order by President Stocks at 5:30 p.m., October 14, 2009, in the District Office Board Room, 220 South K Street, Oxnard, California.

Trustees present: President Steve W. Stocks; Vice President Robert Q. Valles, Clerk Socorro López Hanson, Trustees Ken Benefield and Dick Jáquez.

Administration present: Interim Superintendent Dr. Bob Carter; Assistant Superintendents Dr. Rocky Valles, Human Resources; Martha Mutz, Educational Services; and Randy Winton, Business Services; Directors Angelita Dalan, Fiscal Services and Tim Watson Williams, Food and Nutrition Services; Principals Judy Perkins and Adrian Palazuelos; and Nancy R. Serros, Executive Assistant to the Board of Trustees.

Student Representative to the Board of Trustees present: Bryant Jones.

Guests present: Staff Reporter Marjorie Hernandez, The Ventura County Star.

#### PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Trustee Ken Benefield led the Pledge of Allegiance.

## ADOPTION OF AGENDA:

It was moved by Trustee Valles, seconded by Trustee Benefield and carried unanimously, that the Closed Session items be pulled, and that the agenda be adopted, as amended. Items were then considered in the order in which they appear in these minutes.

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

August 23, 2009, Special Board Meeting Trustee Benefield moved to approve the August 28, 2009 special board meeting minutes; seconded by Trustee López Hanson; motion carried unanimously.

September 9, 2009, Regular Board Meeting

Trustee López Hanson moved to approve the September 9, 2009 regular board meeting minutes; seconded by Trustee Valles; motion carried unanimously.

**CLOSED SESSION:** 

President Stocks announced there were no closed session items. The Board adjourned at 5:35 p.m.

RECONVENE IN PUBLIC:

The Board reconvened in open session at 6:30 p.m.

AUDIENCE TO ADDRESS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

Heather Kurpiewski, parent, addressed the Board to express her concerns regarding the proposal to cut the 2009-2010 school year and no attempt from the district to gather input from parents and the community regarding this issue. She opined Hueneme High School was already being short-changed because classes did not start on time and there were changes to the curriculum putting most students behind three weeks.

At the request of President Stocks, Assistant Superintendent Valles briefly described the three calendar options presented by the district and OFTSE for the 2009-2010 school year. Dr. Valles stated the district and OFTSE worked together with a committee to put together three calendar options for employees. An election was held on October 12, 2009, certificated, classified and paraeducators voted on and approved, Option C by a majority vote.

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## AUDIENCE TO ADDRESS THE **BOARD OF TRUSTEES -**Continued:

Lina Hul and Bexy Gomez, students from Hueneme High School addressed the Board regarding their concerns about the grade level office for twelfth graders being shared by a lower level class; twelfth graders do not have a Dean of Students, a guidance technician, and a counselor. Ms. Hul and Ms. Gomez stated the students would like to have the employees reinstated so that twelfth graders will continue to have the same support they have had for the past three years.

Harold Ceja, resident of Oxnard. Mr. Ceja asked the Board to consider naming the new high school after a former graduate and employee of the District, Dr. Robert Serros.

## SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORTS:

Carter, Ed.D.

Update: Interim Superintendent Bob Dr. Cater stated that considering everything discussed this evening, and the financial picture, the schools are doing very well. Dr. Carter introduced Student Representative Bryant Jones.

> Bryant introduced the district ASB Presidents - Carson Bickel, Rio Mesa High School; Rianna Dimalanta, Channel Islands High School; Aaron Cruz, Pacifica High School; Amy Sanchez, Oxnard High School; Arianna Segura, Hueneme High School; and Nick Henggeler, Adolfo Camarillo High School.

> Mr. Henggeler reported that the first ODC meeting was held and representatives discussed upcoming homecoming activities, keeping the lines of communication open among the schools, and stated an ODC meeting will be held every month.

> Trustees welcomed and thanked ASB Presidents for attending the meeting; and discussed the merits of volunteerism, when ODC meetings are held and what is discussed at the meetings, and the ACHS Theatre. Lastly, Trustees extended congratulations for taking leadership in their perspective schools and encouraged them to pursue their goals.

Board Recognition: Mr. Pablo Ortiz and Ms. Alma Mendoza, of Radio Formula

Ms. Guadalupe Reyes-Castillo, Director of Migrant Education informed Trustees that with the assistance of Pablo Ortiz and Alma Mendoza, she provided information to parents that helped them navigate through the education system via a talk show presented by Radio Formula. On behalf of the Board of Trustees, Mr. Ortiz was presented a Certificate of Appreciation by Trustee Valles. Also recognized, but not present to accept her award was Ms. Alma Mendoza, talk show host.

Board Report: Testing Report – API and AYP Scores

Ms. Martha Mutz, Assistant Superintendent, Educational Services, introduced Ms. Rebecca Buettner, Director of Assessment and Accountability, to overview the Academic Performance Index and Adequate Yearly Progress. Ms. Buettner reported that the API was introduced for accountability purposes to measure schools' annual progress, rank schools and districts, and assess student mastery of the content standards. Ms. Buettner reviewed with Trustees the APIs for the comprehensive sites, along with their significant subgroups, and answered questions. She stated AYP targets continue to rise and described the alternate ways to meet AYP. She reported the District did not make AYP this year and is in Program Improvement Year two. The importance of motivating students was discussed.

#### RESOLUTION NO 09-47

## RESOLUTION ELIMINATING POSITIONS AND ORDERING LAYOFFS IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE DUE TO LACK OF FUNDS AND LACK OF WORK

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Oxnard Union High School District has reported to this Board that there is a lack of funds and/or a lack of work and that, as a result thereof, the level of services in all classifications must be reduced; and

WHEREAS, the Board has this date adopted the Superintendent's recommendations and ordered a reduction of classified services, and it appears to this Board that due to a lack of funds and/or a lack of work, it is necessary to eliminate certain classified positions and to layoff affected employees as specified hereinafter.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND as follows:

- That each of the foregoing recitals is true and correct. 1.
- Because of lack of funds and lack of work, certain services now being provided by the District 2. through its classified employees will be reduced or discontinued, and the positions set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, listed by classification, full-time equivalents, and effective date, shall be eliminated.
- The Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to carry forth layoff proceedings resulting 3. from the elimination of positions ordered hereinabove, including proceedings for layoff provided by the exercise of displacement rights and to serve layoff notices to employees affected thereby. Where an employee displaces an employee holding a position in another class, the Superintendent is hereby authorized and directed to carry forth layoff proceedings resulting therefore and to serve layoff notices to employees affected thereby. All such layoffs shall be as of the designated effective date or as soon thereafter as permitted by the applicable layoff procedures.
- In the event that an employee affected by the layoff proceedings authorized by this resolution chooses to retire or resign from District service, or other appropriate resolution is made, the Superintendent is authorized to rescind the layoff.
