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### Minutes of the February 21, 2007, regular meeting of the Board of Trustees

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#### CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Oxnard Union High School District was called to order by President Dick Jaquez at 5:30 p.m., February 21, 2007, in the District Office Board Room.

#### RECONVENE IN PUBLIC: REPORT OF CLOSED SESSION ACTION

The Board reconvened in open session at 8:06 p.m. President Jaquez announced that no action had been taken during closed session.

President Jaquez announced that one of the district's long-time employees of over 40 years, Ms. Sherrill Tucker, passed away earlier today. He commented that this district had never had a better supporter than Ms. Tucker. She always had a smile, regardless of the situation and if anyone was going against the district – that young lady was very feisty in defending us.

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#### Comments - continued

President Jaquez asked Board of Trustees if they had comments to share.

- Trustee López Hanson commented she admired Sherrill very much and owed her a lot. When she first came on the Board, Sherrill was the one that showed her the ropes.
- Trustee Pinkard commented that Sherrill was someone you could always count on. If the day was cloudy – she was the *sunshine*. Sherrill was always cheerful, nothing could get her down and she loved OUHSD. It was a pleasure working with her.
- Trustee Stocks remembered Sherrill when she first came to the district right after graduating from high school. Her first assignment was school secretary at Hueneme High School, than she transferred to Channel Islands and Oxnard High Schools. She was an excellent administrative secretary and known as the *mother of the district* and, a very competent individual.
- Trustee Valles commented that he first met Sherrill while serving on the High School Advisory Board in the 70s. Sherrill always made people feel comfortable. She had a lot of knowledge about the schools and she knew where to go to get the answers. Once he became a Board Member, Sherrill was there to help him in any way possible. She was a great person and will be greatly missed by all of us.

President Jaquez asked for a moment of silence in memory of Sherrill, and sends prayers to her and her family.

#### AUDIENCE TO ADDRESS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Mr. Luciano Ortiz, Chairman for the West Village Community, spoke on behalf of the WVC concerning the proposed rezoning of the area across Pacifica High School by a developer for 89 homes. This property is currently zoned as a park/sports area and the developer has been misinforming parents, students and the community about building a swimming pool for use by the students of PHS and the City of Oxnard. To his knowledge, the developer has not made arrangements with the district to share the pool with the students of Pacifica and is sending a message of false hope. Mr. Ortiz informed Trustees that due to the proximity of the railroad tracks, the school will not be able to use the facility. He suggested there should be some planning with the parks and recreation, the community, and the district. Mr. Ortiz asked Trustees to take a look at this situation and possibly make a resolution to inform the community that there has been no dialog between the developer and the Board of Trustees.

#### SUPERINTENDENT UPDATES

##### *Board Recognition – Oxnard High School Decathlon Team*

Martha Mutz, Assistant Superintendent-Educational Services introduced Mr. Robert Bornemann, OHS Decathlon Coach. Mr. Bornemann stated he was very proud of this year's Academic Decathlon team. This was a three-year building process where new records and benchmarks were set for any OUHSD team and the first time in the history of the district that a team has been given an at-large bid to compete in the state competition. He proclaimed it was an honor to be ranked eighth in California and 15<sup>th</sup> in the nation. Mr. Bornemann quizzed Trustees and administrative staff by asking sample questions that students might encounter at the competition. Mr. Bornemann thanked assistant coach Chris Conti; Principal James Edwards for his assistance and financial support; Superintendent Dunlap for helping OHS move on to the state competition and for her incredible support; the OHS PTSA who also provided financial support; OHS teachers Jim McCrory, Kathy Beckham, Jennifer Otani, Lori Beyer, Kris Roberts, and Tom McGuirk; several parents who supplied food and moral support; and many others outside the district who also provided support. On behalf of the Board of Trustees, Ms. Mutz and Mr. Bornemann presented certificates to team members. Assistant Principal Yvonne Peck accepted a plaque on behalf of OHS.

##### *Board Recognition – Rio Mesa High School WorldQuest Challenge Team Winner*

Ms. Mutz introduced Mr. Scott Ingram, RMHS parent who informed the Board that this was RMHS's third year in local competition in WorldQuest. He provided a brief description of WorldQuest and introduced the WorldQuest Challenge Team Winners. Ms. Mutz and Mr. Ingram presented certificates to team members.

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#### *Board Recognition – New School Counselors*

Mr. Roger Rice, Assistant Superintendent-Human Resources introduced new counselors to Board of Trustees. Mr. Rice stated that it was possible to improve the level of service provided to the students and parents of the district by hiring additional staff under AB 1802. To help facilitate this process the following counselors were hired: Marissa Stuteville, ACHS; Keny Galdamez and Shirley Moore, CIHS; Robert Sierra, HHS; Scott McNutt and Tommy Takeda, OHS; Peggy Helmstedter, PHS; and Michelle Phillips, RMHS. On behalf of the Board of Trustees, President Jaquez welcomed the new counselors to the district family.

#### *Superintendent's Reports*

Dr. Dunlap extended congratulations to:

- Roger Rice and Melissa Ramirez who presented on High School Reform issues at the Ventura County School Board dinner in January. They did an outstanding job!
- Martha Mutz and James Edwards for writing a successful Academic Partnership Grant in the amount of \$250,000, for the 2007-2008 school year. OHS will receive \$50,000 a year for the next five years.
- Kim Dallape for being named Teacher of the Year by the Camarillo Chamber of Commerce. Ms. Dallape will be recognized at an upcoming Chamber meeting.

#### STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Miss Melissa Ramirez, Student Representative to the Board of Trustees, reported:

- She had the opportunity to present at the Ventura County School Board dinner along with Mr. Rice. She spoke about the struggles students have in the classroom and where students can find assistance.
- At the last ODC meeting, they discussed student activities at the sites such as senior ball, Sadie Hawkins Dance, prom and several other recreational activities taking place. One of those being a Male Pageant contest, with the possibility of holding a "Mr. OUHSD" from all seniors throughout the district.
- In the area of academics, seniors are receiving letters of acceptance from California state universities and private schools and applying for scholarships and grants.
- A group called "Invisible Children" visited CIHS. They presented a video on the crises occurring in Uganda with children running away from home due to military recruitment. The Peer Resource Group at CIHS has turned to School-for-School organization for help in assisting the children from Uganda. She hopes other district schools will get involved in this worthy cause.

- BOARD MEMBERS' REPORTS AND COMMUNICATION
- President Jaquez's comments, reports and concerns:
- The reauthorization of NCLB is coming up. There is litigation on NCLB based on the fact that students are asked to take the test only in English. The federal government allows testing in other languages, while the State of California says only English.
  - He attended OHS's Library Open House and was very impressed with how knowledgeable the student was that gave the tour.
  - He informed Trustees he would be attending the Cal Lutheran University Presidential Inaugural event on Friday.
- Trustee Valles' comments, reports and concerns:
- He visited the area high schools to look at the current Industrial Tech facilities and what the potential is of expanding them.
  - He informed Trustees that HAAS, Inc. is willing to donate equipment to our facilities. This is a win, win situation for our district and administrative staff is looking into this.
  - He announced the new ballroom dance class offered at Frontier High School is doing well and students receive five (5) credits towards P.E.
  - He informed Trustees he read that some of the LAUSD teachers are against the ROTC Program because they are not in favor of the war. Teachers are discouraging students from enrolling in the program. It is his opinion the ROTC Program helps students to mature and learn discipline. He hoped the district's teachers would not become politically involved in these types of situations.

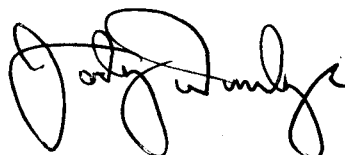
