CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Oxnard Union High School District was called to order by Board President Dick Jaquez at 5:30 p.m., May 9, 2007, in the District Office Board Room.

AUDIENCE TO ADDRESS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Mr. Karl Lawson, President of RMHS Pageantry Booster Club, introduced incoming President Bertha Perez. Mr. Lawson expressed concerns about the renovation process at Rio Mesa and the availability of certain activities during this process. He would like to work with the district to make sure appropriate storage for instruments and a practice field are available. Superintendent Dunlap stated arrangements have been made with both principals involved to assure that RMHS Band has a proper storage facility and practice field at OHS, and would follow-up with Principals Rickard and Edwards to confirm these arrangements. Mr. Lawson thanked the district for their support throughout the year.

On behalf of County Superintendent Chuck Weis, Mr. Joe Mendoza, Director of Migrant Education Program, Ventura County Office of Education, presented an award to Trustee Valles. Mr. Mendoza expressed appreciation and thanks to Trustee Valles for volunteering to participate as a judge in the County-wide Speech and Debate competition last weekend. Trustee Valles commented it was a wonderful way to spend the day and help children who most need all the help we can offer. He said it was a great experience seeing all these teachers and facilitators working together, that it takes a lot of patience to be with these students, the experience was very positive, and thanked Dr. Weis and staff for the outstanding job of putting this program together.

Mr. Pete Estrada, representing the adult baseball program, stated that his requests for use of facilities were not being approved and opined that a new baseball league is being given preferential treatment and wanted to bring this to the attention of the Board. Superintendent Dunlap stated she would look into the matter and report back to Trustees and Mr. Estrada.

Wilbert Quinones, was present to advocate for the adult baseball program. He stated the adult baseball players are being treated unfairly, the programs keep kids out of trouble and his baseball team was receiving second-hand treatment.

BOARD RECOGNITION: *Visual Communications Contest Winners*

Martha Mutz, Assistant Superintendent-Educational Services was pleased to announce the winners of the District's Annual Visual Communications Contest. She reported the Visual and Performing Art Chairpersons from each school site selected students' art to be entered into the district competition and all student art was displayed at the museum during the month of April. Ms. Mutz and Visual Arts Teacher Erica Kern introduced first place winner Jenny Ta from Oxnard High School. Ms. Kern presented books to Ms. Ta and encouraged her to keep on drawing. On behalf of the Board of Trustees, Trustee Pinkard presented a certificate of achievement to Ms. Ta and asked her to explain the drawing process. Ms. Mutz and Visual Arts Teacher Terry Arena introduced the second place winner Jamie Pillsbury from Adolfo Camarillo High School. Ms. Arena described Jamie as a "hard-working, very focused student who never takes the easy way out, and ACHS was very proud of her." Trustee Pinkard presented a certificate of achievement to Ms. Pillsbury and asked her to describe her art work.

Superintendent Dunlap announced that at last week's Impact II Teacher Recognition Dinner, Ms. Terry Arena, Art Department Chair, was recognized County-wide for instruction in the classroom. Ms. Arena received an Impact II Grant for her accomplishments.

SPECIAL REPORT: HEALTH ACADEMY – *PACIFICA HIGH SCHOOL*

Ms. Mutz announced that two schools have moved forward with academies and have activities up and running – one will be presenting tonight and the other in June. Ms. Mutz introduced Assistant Principal, Bijou Beltran and Ms. Erin Huizinga, Health and Science teacher/Coordinator from Pacifica High School. Mmes. Beltran and Huizinga presented a PowerPoint overview of the Health Academy Program at Pacifica. They each highlighted areas of the Health Academy such as how the program was implemented, how students enrolled and were selected for the program, the type of classes offered, the collaboration with the local junior highs and community colleges, the connectivity the students have with each other and staff, and the curriculum.

JOB DESCRIPTION –
*Coordinator School to
Work Programs*

Dr. Roger Rice, Assistant Superintendent of Human Resources stated that the reclassification of the job description up for consideration falls in line with the previous Health Academy presentation and recommended that the Vocational School-to-Work Coordinator job description be upgraded to the direct level replicated by the kinds of program that were described in the presentation. He stated there have been significant changes to the position such as work year, job responsibilities and asked the Board to consider and support the recommended job description. Assistant Superintendent Mutz reiterated the recommendation made by Mr. Rice and asked for the Board's approval, stating the reclassification would improve the Career Technical Education program, the director would work with the school sites to improve student enrollment, work as a liaison with local businesses, work with teachers to implement the CTE standards; thus providing a connection for students from school to future career opportunities.

Trustee Valles congratulated staff for coming up with the job description and asked that when the position is filled that that person be provided as much support as possible to move the program in the right direction. He stated students' grade point averages rise when involved in vocational education and he expects great things for these programs.

Trustee Jaquez asked if the position will take care of all academies and over-see them, and Trustee López Hanson inquired who had applied and whether the IB was part of the program. Mr. Rice stated that academies funded by Carl Perkins grant will be covered, and the IB program has a different focus and they are in the process of putting the application together.

Interests and Comments

Trustee López Hanson requested a report on the number of students accepted at colleges/universities. She received erroneous information that only one student from Oxnard High was accepted at UCLA and told that person she would report back the correct number of students accepted at UC campuses. In response to Trustee López Hanson's request, Superintendent Dunlap reported Oxnard High had 57 seniors at UC campuses, and 79 identified juniors who are CSU eligible. Trustee Stocks commented that the universities send out a list every year indicating the names of students and high schools of those students accepted by UC campuses. Ms. Mutz concurred with Trustee Stocks and will provide a copy of the list to Trustees.

Trustee Pinkard asked for an update on the Channel Islands investigation. Superintendent Dunlap will follow-up on her request.

Trustee Jaquez announced he had good news – there was a 23% savings in Workers Compensation, which translates into approximately \$800,000. He commended Mr. Gama for exhibiting such a passion for his job, and extended congratulations to Steven Gama and his staff for doing such great work.


