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

Texas Education Code – Chapter 37.108

- requires each district to have an EOP that addresses
 Prevention, Mitigation, Preparedness, Response and
 Recovery. Once the EOP is in place, drilling and
 training components of emergency management begin
 to identify areas in need of improvement, clarify roles
 and improve coordination.
- Additionally, the Texas Legislature requires school districts to conduct a safety and security audit of their schools and facilities at least once every three years.

EOP must....

- Be Multi-Hazard in nature
- Use the ICS and be NIMS compliant
- Be reviewed and updated on an annual basis
- Developed by your school safety planning team
- Contain updated maps
- Contain evacuation routes
- Roof & Underground access
- Room #s
- Identify personnel with specialized training
- Contain current student enrollment
- Contain documentation for Drills Training

Most workplace injuries are due to all types of slips, trips, and falls






