




# **Student Spotlight**

### VIEW HPS COVID NUMBERS

Hattiesburg Public Schools make weekly reports of cases among students, teachers and staff, number of outbreaks, and teachers and students under quarantine of COVID-19 exposure to the Mississippi State Department of Health (MSDH). The numbers included in the report are from BOTH on-campus and offcampus incidents. If you do not see a school in the MSDH report, it is because MSDH only lists schools with reported cases.

# **Did you Know Facts and Tidbits about HPS?**

- The number of students performing on grade level in Reading has increased every year since 2016, moving from 21.2% to 33.4%.
- The number of students performing on grade level in math has increased every year since 2016, moving from 21.6% to 37.8%.
- The graduation rate has increased from 72.9% (2016) to 83.1% (2020)
- Decreased dropout rate from 16.2% (2016) to 12.5% (2020)
- Dual enrollment acceleration has increased from 23 (2016) to 54.5 (2019)
- Kindergarten readiness increased from 27% (2016) to 44% (2019)
- District Accountability Rating increased from 482 to 534
