MAY

1 **National deadline for accepting college admission offers.** Be sure to notify colleges of non-acceptance, as well as acceptance of the college of your choice. **ALSO, select acceptance college in Naviance.**
1 **Grade check for seniors not on track to graduate.** After mid-term testing, counselors will send parents a notification letter to those seniors failing a required course or missing graduation requirements. These students will be placed on a Commencement Ceremony non-participation list.

7 **Senior Prom – 7 to 10 pm at MoPop in Seattle** (Museum of Pop Culture)
TBD **Counselors visit senior social studies classes to discuss Post High School Plan (Senior Survey), Final Transcript Requests & Senior Awards Forms. These forms must be returned to Counseling office NO LATER than May 31st.**

1 All independent out-of-district coursework must be completed with official transcript submitted to Counseling for verification. Add-to-transcript form must accompany transcript. Participation in Commencement Ceremony may be in jeopardy for out-of-district coursework submitted after this date.

- TBD **FINAL EXAMS** – altered schedule.
- 10 **Final day for seniors to pay or clear fines before Commencement. *Diplomas and final transcripts INCLUDING THOSE SENT TO COLLEGES, are held until fines and fees are cleared.***
- 13 **FINAL Grade Check** and clearance for *all seniors* to be cleared for graduation

- TBD **Senior Memories Assembly - Staff & students will attend the assembly.** Students who were previously failing, are now passing a required course, and have met all other graduation requirements will be reinstated to the Commencement roster and may participate in the Commencement Ceremony. Students will be notified of reinstatement by the Counseling department. If your student is not reinstated, they will not participate in the Commencement exercises.
